Практикум ЕГЭ по английскому языку предназначен как для работы в классе, так и для самостоятельного контроля знаний.

Предлагаемое пособие содержит тренировочные варианты тестовых заданий Единого государственного экзамена (ЕГЭ) по английскому языку, составленных с учетом всех особенностей и требований ЕГЭ.

Особое внимание уделяется отработке навыков правильного заполнения бланка ответов.

Учащемуся предлагается выполнить реальный экзаменационный тест, заполняя при этом реальный бланк ответов на задания ЕГЭ.

Приводятся примеры типичных ошибок при заполнении бланков, которые даже при правильно выполненных заданиях ведут к снижению оценки.

Компакт-диск содержит тексты для раздела «Аудирование», воспроизведенные профессиональными дикторами и носителями языка.

Практикум предназначен для учащихся 11 классов общеобразовательных учреждений, преподавателей и методистов, использующих тесты для подготовки к Единому государственному экзамену.

ВВЕДЕНИЕ

Предлагаемое пособие представляет собой три типовых варианта тестовых заданий по всем разделам Единого государственного экзамена (ЕГЭ). Задания каждого варианта соответствуют формату, с которым учащиеся встретятся на реальном экзамене. В пособии также представлены материалы, которыми пользуются экзаменаторы в ходе процедуры экзамена и проверки знаний учащихся. В приложении к каждому тесту даны тексты-скрипты для аудирования, а также карточка экзаменатора-собеседника, что позволит учащимся понять критерии оценок устной части экзамена. Задания, направленные на проверку навыков аудирования, сопровождаются аудиозаписью на диске. Пособие также содержит ключи к заданиям на аудирование и проверку лексико-грамматического материала, что, безусловно, дает возможность более эффективно работать над предлагаемым материалом. Уровень сложности представленного материала соответствует требованиям программы по иностранному языку для общеобразовательной школы.

Утвержденный формат экзамена включает в себя задания трех типов: А — выбор правильного ответа из предложенных вариантов; В — установка соответствий или необходимость дать краткий ответ; С — развернутый ответ в рамках творческих заданий на письмо и говорение. Первая часть каждого теста включает задания на аудирование А и В типов. Время на выполнение определяется продолжительностью звучания аудиозаписи. Вторая часть содержит задания на проверку усвоения детальной и общей информации прочитанного текста различного формата. В данном разделе представлены задания А и В типов. Рекомендуемое время выполнения всех заданий на чтение — 30 минут. Третья часть включает лексикограмматические задания А и В типов различной сложности. Рекомендуемое время — 30 минут. Следующая четвертая часть состоит из заданий, требующих написание открытки или личного письма. Рекомендуемое время увеличено до 45 минут. Последняя часть каждого теста включает задания (тип С) на проверку навыков монологического высказывания, умения составлять диалог с целью обмена фактической информацией в рамках заданной темы и диалога с делью обмена оценочной информацией. Предполагаемое время проведения процедуры собеседования составляет 10−15 минут.

Рекомендуется выполнять задания в том порядке, в котором они даны в пособии, т.к. это соответствует ходу реального экзамена. Разрешается делать черновые пометки на листах, содержащих задания, но не на бланках ответов. После выполнения заданий возможна проверка полученных ответов соответственно данным ключам. Рекомендуется также использовать бланки ответов, с тем, чтобы не испытывать трудностей при их заполнении в ходе реального экзамена.

ОПИСАНИЕ БЛАНКОВ ЕДИНОГО ГОСУДАРСТВЕННОГО ЭКЗАМЕНА

Бланк ответов № 1

Фон бланка — малиновый.

В средней части бланка ответов № 1 расположены поля для записи ответов на задания типа A с выбором ответа из предложенных вариантов. Максимальное количество таких заданий — 60. Максимальное число вариантов ответов на каждое задание — 4.

Ниже этого приведены поля для замены ошибочных ответов на задания типа А и поля для служебного использования. Максимальное количество замен ошибочных ответов — 12.

Далее размещены поля для записи результатов выполнения заданий типа B с ответом в краткой форме (слово или число). Максимальное количество кратких ответов — 20. Максимальное количество символов в одном ответе — 17.

В нижней части бланка ответов № 1 предусмотрены поля для замены ошибочных ответов на задания типа В. Максимальное количество замен ошибочных ответов — 6.

Бланк ответов № 2

Фон бланка — бежевый.

Поле для ответов на задания располагается на оставшейся части бланка, включая оборотную сторону, и разлиновано пунктирными линиями «в клеточку».

ИЗВЛЕЧЕНИЕ ИЗ ИНСТРУКЦИИ ПО ЗАПОЛНЕНИЮ БЛАНКОВ

1. Общая часть

- 1.1. При проведении ЕГЭ экзаменационная работа выпускника (поступающего) оформляется на бланках, утвержденных приказом Рособрнадзора.
- 1.2. Информация, внесенная в бланки ЕГЭ, сканируется и обрабатывается с использованием ЭВМ. Поэтому при заполнении полей бланков ЕГЭ необходимо точно соблюдать настоящую инструкцию.

2. Основные принципы заполнения бланков ЕГЭ

- 2.1. Все бланки ЕГЭ заполняются яркими черными чернилами. Допускается использование гелевой, капиллярной или перьевой ручки. В случае отсутствия у выпускника (поступающего) указанных ручек и использования им, вопреки инструкции, шариковой ручки контур каждого символа при заполнении необходимо аккуратно обводить 2-3 раза, чтобы исключить «проблески» по линии символов.
- 2.2. Линия метки («крестик») в полях меток не должна быть слишком толстой. Если ручка оставляет слишком толстую линию, то вместо крестика в поле метки нужно провести только одну диагональ квадрата (любую). Использовать иные символы, кроме «крестика», нельзя (см. помету 2 стр. 11).
- 2.3. Выпускник (поступающий) должен изображать каждую цифру и букву во всех заполняемых полях бланка регистрации, бланка ответов № 1 и регистрационной части бланка ответов № 2, тщательно копируя образец ее написания из верхней части бланка с образцами написания символов. Небрежное написание символов может привести к тому, что при автоматизированной обработке символ может быть распознан неправильно (см. помету 6 стр. 11).
- 2.4. Каждое поле в бланках заполняется, начиная с первой позиции (см. помету 8 стр. 11).
- 2.5. Если выпускник (поступающий) не имеет информации для заполнения поля, он должен оставить его пустым (не делать прочерков). Исправления не допускаются (см. помету 1 стр. 11).
 - 2.6. Категорически запрещается:
- делать в полях бланков, вне полей бланков или в полях, заполненных типографским способом (номер варианта, штрихкоды), какие-либо записи и пометки, не относящиеся к содержанию полей бланков (см. помету 11 стр. 11);
- использовать для заполнения бланков цветные ручки вместо черной, карандаш (даже для черновых записей на бланках), средства для исправления внесенной в бланки информации («замазку» и др.).
- 2.7. На бланках ответов № 1 и № 2 не должно быть пометок, содержащих информацию о личности выпускника (поступающего).
- 2.8 При записи ответов необходимо строго следовать инструкциям по выполнению работы (к группе заданий, отдельным заданиям), указанным в контрольном измерительном материале (далее КИМ).

3. Заполнение бланка ответов № 1

- 3.1. В средней части бланка ответов № 1 расположены поля для записи ответов на задания с выбором ответа из предложенных вариантов (типа А). Максимальное количество таких заданий 60. Максимальное число вариантов ответов на каждое задание 4.
- 3.2. Область ответов на задания типа А состоит из горизонтального ряда номеров заданий КИМа. Под каждым номером задания расположен вертикальный столбик из четырех

клеточек. Для того чтобы отметить номер ответа, который выпускник (поступающий) считает правильным, под номером задания он должен поставить метку («крестик») в ту клеточку, номер которой соответствует номеру выбранного им ответа. Для удобства работы клеточки на левом и правом полях бланка ответов № 1 пронумерованы.

- 3.3. В области ответов на задания типа А нельзя допускать случайных пометок, клякс, полос размазанных чернил и т.д. (см. помету 5 стр. 11), так как при автоматизированной обработке это может быть распознано как ответы на задания КИМа. Если не удалось избежать случайных пометок, их следует отменить в области «Замена ошибочных ответов на задания типа А».
- 3.4. При заполнении области ответов на задания типа А следует строго соблюдать инструкции по выполнению работы (к группе заданий, отдельным заданиям), приведенные в КИМе. В столбце, соответствующем номеру задания в области ответов на задания типа А, следует делать не более одной метки (см. помету 3 стр. 11). При наличии нескольких меток такое задание заведомо будет считаться неверно выполненным.
- 3.5. Можно отменить ошибочно отмеченный ответ и поставить другой. Замена ответа осуществляется заполнением соответствующих полей в области замены ошибочных ответов на задания типа А. Нельзя зачеркивать ошибочный ответ (см. помету 4 стр. 11).
- 3.6. Заменить можно не более 12 ошибочных ответов по всем заданиям типа А. Для этого в соответствующее поле области замены ошибочных ответов на задания типа А следует внести номер ошибочно заполненного задания, а в строку клеточек внести метку верного ответа. В случае если в поля замены ошибочного ответа внесен несколько раз номер одного и того же задания, то будет учитываться последнее исправление (отсчет сверху вниз и слева направо).

Область для ответов на задания типа В

- 3.7. Ниже области замены ошибочных ответов на задания типа А размещены поля для записи ответов на задания типа В (задания с кратким ответом). Максимальное количество ответов 20. Максимальное количество символов в одном ответе 17.
- 3.8. Краткий ответ записывается справа от номера задания типа В в области ответов с названием «Результаты выполнения заданий типа В с ответом в краткой форме».
- 3.9. Краткий ответ можно давать только в виде слова, одного целого числа или комбинации букв и цифр, если в инструкции по выполнению работы не указано, что ответ можно дать с использованием запятых для записи ответа в виде десятичной дроби или в виде перечисления требуемых в задании пунктов. Каждая цифра, буква, запятая или знак минус (если число отрицательное) записывается в отдельную клеточку, строго по образцу из верхней части бланка. Не разрешается использовать при записи ответа на задания типа В никаких иных символов, кроме символов кириллицы, латиницы, арабских цифр, запятой и знака дефис (минус) (см. помету 7 стр. 11).
- 3.10. Если требуется написать в ответе термин, состоящий из двух слов, то они пишутся слитно без пробела или другого разделителя (см. помету 9 стр. 11), если в инструкции по выполнению работы не указана другая форма написания ответа на данное задание. Если в таком термине окажется букв больше, чем клеточек в поле для ответа, то вторую часть термина можно писать более убористо. Термин следует писать полностью. Любые сокращения запрещены (см. помету 10 стр. 11). Исправления не допускаются (см. пометы 12, 13 стр. 11).
- 3.11. Если кратким ответом должно быть слово, пропущенное в некотором предложении, то это слово нужно писать в той форме (род, число, падеж и т.п.), в которой оно должно стоять в предложении.
- 3.12. Если числовой ответ получается в виде дроби, то ее следует округлить до целого числа по правилам округления, если в инструкции по выполнению работы не требуется записать ответ в виде десятичной дроби. Например: 2,3 округляется до 2; 2,5 до 3; 2,7 —

- до 3. Это правило должно выполняться для тех заданий, для которых в инструкции по выполнению работы нет указаний, что ответ нужно дать в виде десятичной дроби.
- 3.13. В ответе, записанном в виде десятичной дроби, в качестве разделителя следует указывать запятую.
- 3.14. Записывать ответ в виде математического выражения или формулы запрещается. Нельзя писать названия единиц измерения (градусы, проценты, метры, тонны и т.д.). Недопустимы заголовки или комментарии к ответу.
- 3.15. В бланке ответов № 1 предусмотрены поля для записи новых вариантов ответов на задания типа В взамен ошибочно записанных. Максимальное количество таких исправлений 6.
- 3.16. Для изменения уже внесенного в бланк ответа на задание типа В надо в соответствующих полях отмены проставить номер исправляемого задания типа В и записать новое значение верного ответа на указанное задание.

4. Заполнение бланка ответов № 2

- 4.1. Бланк ответов № 2 предназначен для записи ответов на задания с развернутым ответом.
- 4.2. Для выполнения заданий с развернутым ответом по литературе, математике, истории России, физике и информатике используется бланк ответов № 2 увеличенного размера (формата A3).
- 4.3. При недостатке места для ответов на лицевой стороне бланка ответов № 2 выпускник (поступающий) может продолжить записи на оборотной стороне бланка, сделав внизу лицевой стороны запись «смотри на обороте». Для удобства все страницы бланка ответов № 2 пронумерованы и разлинованы пунктирными линиями «в клеточку».



The middle-aged woman's voice on the other end of the phone was icily imperious: "Oliver, come and speak to this lady, now, she's from clearing."

Judging by Oliver's rather slow response, it was apparent he was reluctant to discuss his plans for further education, in the light of his disappointing A-level results. But when he finally made it to the receiver, he was met with the soothing, sympathetic tones of a clearing centre adviser.

At universities across the country, similar scenes were played out from the moment clearing lines were opened, in some cases as early as 8.30am.

Candidates who missed their target results by a grade or two desperately dialled their admissions tutors to discover if they would still be accepted. Those who did much worse than expected, turned to clearing, the system through which temporarily unplaced students apply for spare places on degree courses.

"I'm here to help by matchmaking students with courses," said Ryan Saunders, 29, a paid volunteer at Kingston University. "I've just had a bloke who skipped lots of his exams and wanted to get on a business course, for which he needed 180 points, but he only had 60. Certainly he wasn't accepted by us. He was quite a persuasive talker. I personally think he's got a great career in sales."

Figures show that there was a rise of more than 16,000 people from 2002. Almost one student in 11 found a place on a degree course through clearing.

Universities are typically at pains to stress that students should take time before making major decisions. They claim they are careful of awarding places to applicants who have hitherto shown no interest in a subject. Their advice to anyone who hasn't got into their first choice university is to ring around and see what's available elsewhere rather than simply taking the first course they're offered. It's better to make a considered decision than end up on the wrong course in the wrong place.

All the same, nationwide, there was a mood similar to the opening day of a budget airline internet sale. Anyone who lost their nerve and hesitated ran the risk that the place would be snapped up when they called back later.

At Greenwich University some professional training courses were filled within hours. Nursing, midwifery and education proved popular, followed by newly introduced courses in criminology and forensic science.

With hundreds of clearing places available, the university had 100 phone lines open but was still swamped by the flood of calls just after 10 am, the time when many students received their results.

The overall quality of the students calling up is better than in previous years. Back at Kingston University admissions tutor for geological sciences was confident the majority of his 15 places would be filled through clearing.

"As far as we're concerned, once an applicant is accepted by us it doesn't matter whether they've come through clearing or not," he said. "It often has a positive effect. Some students suddenly realize they need to work harder than they have done in the past."

Ralph worked nights on a plan that promised him a well-paying job in Texas, but through no fault of his own this promise was never realized. In the third year of his marriage with Laura, a firm that was almost identical in size and character with the firm Ralph worked for underwent a change of ownership, and Ralph was approached and asked if he would be interested in joining the overhauled firm. His own job promised only meager security after a series of slow promotions and he was glad of the chance to escape. He met the new owners, and their enthusiasm for him seemed intense. They were prepared to put him in charge of a department and pay him twice what he was getting then. The arrangement was to remain tacit for a month or two, until the new owners had secured their position, but they shook hands warmly and had a drink on the deal, and that night Ralph took Laura out to dinner at an expensive restaurant.

They decided to look for a larger apartment, to have a child, and to buy a secondhand car. They faced their good fortune with perfect calm, for it was what they had expected all along. The city seemed to them a generous place, where people were rewarded either by a sudden and deserved development like this or by the capricious bounty of lawsuits, eccentric and peripheral business ventures, unexpected legacies and other windfalls.

He was twenty-eight years old; poverty and youth were inseparable in his experience, and one was ending with the other. The life they were about to leave had not been hard, and he thought with sentiment of the soiled tablecloth in the Italian restaurant where they usually went for their celebrations, and the high spirits with which Laura on a wet night ran from the subway to the bus stop. But they were drawing away from all this. Shirt sales in department-store basements, lines at meat counters, weak drinks, the roses he brought her up from the subway in the spring, when roses were cheap — these were all unmistakably the souvenirs of the poor, and while they seemed to him good and gentle, he was glad that they would soon be memories.

The reorganization and Ralph's new position hung fire, but they talked about it freely when with friends. "All we need is patience," Laura would say. 





It started with shepherd's pie 30 years ago and now ready-made meals have transformed the nation's eating habits. Britons spent J1.9 billion on ready-made meals last year, twice as much as the French and Germans, four times as much as the Italians and six times as much as the Spanish. Nearly one in three British adults eats a ready-made meal more than once a week. Demand for instant meals increased by 29 per cent between 1998 and 2002 across Europe as a whole but in Britain it increased by 44 per cent.

Britain became the European capital of ready-made meals, second only in the world to America. Some claim that the reason for it is an excuse "Can't cook, won't cook". However, others consider it to be a case of culture. Regular cooking has disappeared first in the US and then in Britain. In France, Germany, Spain, Italy, there is still a tradition of going home to a cooked meal.

Convenience is definitely part of the attraction. A recent survey found that 77 per cent of buyers said they only bought ready meals when they did not have time to cook.

Dr Susan Jebb, head of nutrition at the Medical Research Council, said: "People in the UK work the longest hours, we are very time-poor, and we don't have a strong cultural history of cooking."

The ready-made meal boom also reflects changing social trends in Britain. More people live alone and so are less likely to cook. And with families eating apart more often, ready-meals allow people to eat what they want when they want. Besides, people are becoming much more demanding as there's pressure on time.

But ready meals also reflect changing tastes in food. Britain's multiculturalism has brought a wider range of restaurants than other European countries, and ethnic cuisines, which people are often scared of cooking, are far more popular. One quarter of chilled meals are Indian, and nearly one in five is Chinese. Traditional British food accounts for only 18 per cent of sales.

"We've always had more Chinese and Indian takeaways and more ethnic restaurants", says a consultant nutritionist.

Supermarkets have responded by offering a wider range. "As increasing numbers of British people travel to the Far East and regularly eat out at oriental restaurants, customers are now looking for authentic Eastern foods they can enjoy at home".

The quality of ready-made meals has become better since the 1970s. However, Dr Jebb says: "Ready-made meals tend to be higher in fat, sugar and salt than the meals we would cook ourselves at home. Fat is cheap and it adds flavour. Most of the salt we eat is added by manufacturers — people like it." But it is not necessarily bad. People can choose healthy options, or have ready-made salads. There is a whole generation that has been brought up with ready meals. They haven't grown up with cooking, they have neither the ability nor the desire to cook and that is alarming.

If we cook, we are interested in life. For many of us, cooking is a way of keeping some control over our own health and happiness. There is no way to guarantee a long and healthy life, but there are three ways to make it possible. The first is to drink a lot of water, the second is to walk a lot and the third is to cook.



K: Not at all! I don't look after myself as well as I should do! I just pay attention really. You don't need to do diets or go to the gym daily — just be aware if you've put on a few pounds, then watch what you're eating. A fair bit of my social life has been bound up in it, too, because so many of the staff have become not just colleagues, but friends.

I: Is that the main reason you've stayed here so long?

T: One of the reasons, obviously. I suppose it comes down to the fact that I've been happy here. Teaching in today's world can be immensely difficult, frustrating and stressful, but in a school like this we are extremely privileged — we get all the good bits! There are no real discipline problems, and you are daily in the company of interesting and genuinely pleasant people whose intelligence and legal demands constantly force you to widen your own boundaries as you try to encourage them to widen theirs.

I: So it's been an easy ride from the start, then?

T: No, I don't think anyone would describe teaching as an easy ride, even here. Everybody has moments when they feel exhausted and overwhelmed, usually by the ever increasing paper work! Classes can be uncooperative, and you yourself can be uninspiring. This happens to us all. But the pleasure of having a class that really seems to be enjoying learning is what makes teaching here so rewarding.

I: Would you say that you have enjoyed teaching the younger classes more than the older ones?

T: I like the enthusiasm of the Lower School classes, but one of the greatest privileges here has been to be a Sixth Form Tutor. The tutor groups are small, and the more relaxed and informal atmosphere gives both students and teachers the chance to see each other and to communicate as individual human beings rather than categorized as teacher and pupil.

I: Were there any events which stick in your mind?

T: Yes, the fund raising! In the beginning we had to raise for ourselves almost every penny we spent, and we ran some wonderful events — I particularly remember a very successful Craft Fair. There was a huge variety of goods on display, and it was extremely colourful. But the main fundraiser has got to be the Fashion Show, which we put on about eight years ago. Now that was a show!

I: Finally, have you any regrets about your time here?

T: Not as such, but things have happened in the world of education that I think are to be regretted. In a system which is now driven by League Tables there is a severe danger of losing sight of the real aims of education in its broadest sense. I regret that at University one can no longer take a subject for the pure intellectual pleasure of increasing one's knowledge of it. In today's more practical world, it often seems that it is not understanding which counts, but usefulness to a career. Students tend to assess information, not according to whether it expands their knowledge or understanding, but according to whether it will 'come up in the exam'.

Peter: Oh, enormously. It really was like coming back to my early days and a little scary in some ways. I was not the best of pupils at school. I got into trouble in my time, and approaching the Headmaster's study still sends a shiver down the spine. But I was very warmly received and the school has got a great atmosphere these days.

Interviewer: When did you first realize your talent for writing?

Peter: Yes, a great deal from real people. On is often asked, "do you base your novels on the people you know?" and the standard answer is, "Oh no, I would not dream of doing that!" but in fact you do. Nearly all of my friends have gone into my books. That is certainly one way of making them more realistic.

Interviewer: Can we expect any more of your books to be converted to television?

Peter: One was made into a television film this year and another one is quite likely to get onto television.

Interviewer: What has been your favourite book to write and why?

Peter: That is difficult, very difficult. One is always most excited about the book one is writing at the moment, and one always thinks, that is going to be the best of them all, but looking back there is a book which I wrote back in the 1980's. That had the most success and probably the most interesting plot, so that has to be the one.

Interviewer: What advice would you give to someone who wants to do writing as a career?

Peter: I think first and foremost you have to have a passion for your subject and you have to have a deep knowledge of your subject and that passion and knowledge together will give you an opportunity. I think reading is important. You should read a lot and watch and listen a lot. Besides you have to knock on doors and make yourself a nuisance. And then it's your own persistence and determination. 
